Admissions

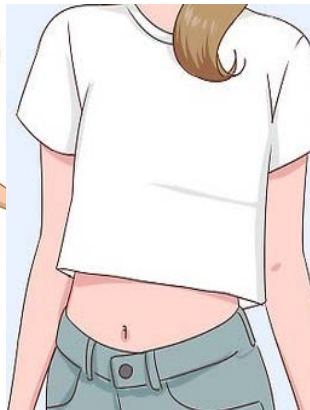
- Angelic House is for women who have a sincere desire to stay sober and create a new life.
- No woman will be refused admission because of race, national origin, religion, sexual orientation, color, creed.
- No person under the influence will be admitted; a clean drug screen is required.
- Each woman admitted to the home must be able to attend to her personal needs independently (self-care).
- Women must have at least 72 hours of sobriety, come from an inpatient treatment center, detox center, hospital, or have been involved in outpatient treatment.
- Each applicant will be medically cleared before residing at the Angelic House.
- Pregnant women cannot be admitted to the home; if pregnancy is determined after admissions, discharge will occur and assistance with appropriate referral(s) will be provided in this process.
- After being medically and clinically cleared and admitted into the house, each resident will be taken to the home, where they will be assigned a room, complete paperwork, sign agreement to rules, and have their belongings inventoried, any personal belongings that are considered contraband will be placed in the office until discharge.
- All cloth-based items will be placed in heat sterilizer between 4-8 hours before being allowed to be stored in the assigned bedroom. This is for every resident, without bias.
- All electronic devices (phones, iPads, computers, etc.) must be turned into staff upon admission to Angelic House

- *House Guidelines*

- Firearms, ammunition, fireworks are not permitted on the premises at any time. No residents will have in their possession any item, which may be deemed a dangerous weapon (knives, straight razors, etc.) Possession of dangerous weapons will be subject to immediate discharge.
- Electronic cigarettes, chewing tobacco, vapors, puffers, hookahs are not permitted at Angelic House.
- NO resident is permitted to perform home piercings, tattoos or hair bleaching/dyeing at Angelic House as it raises a safety concern of potential medical emergencies.
- Sexual toys, porn videos, and pornographic material are not permitted at Angelic House.
- Any items or food brought to the house from family members will be brought to the office to be checked and cleared by staff.
- Residents are not allowed to bring any hair products, makeup, nail polish to the visitation time, books and crossword puzzles will be allowed.

Clothing Guidelines

What Not to Wear:



- * NO leggings with a T shirt (shirt must fall past thighs)
- * NO short shorts (must come down to knee)/
- * NO tank tops/ camis without a covering shirt, jacket or sweater
- * NO low-cut shirts showing cleavage
- * NO crop tops
- * NO pajama pants in public
- * NO drug and alcohol use suggestive clothing
- * NO house shoes, slippers in public
